

What is Learning by Competing about?



The **“Promotion of Training in Robotics and of mobility, by the participation in International Competitions in Robotics”** Project is a two year Project, running from November 2019 to October 2021, co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission.

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It is implemented by a consortium of seven (7) partners

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from five (5) countries: France, Portugal, Spain, Italy and UK

The project aims to test and **transfer the pedagogic approach of “Learning by Competing”**, tested by CEPROF, to other VET schools in other European countries



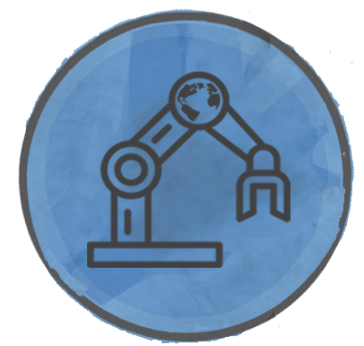
What are the objectives of Learning By Competing?

- Creating and testing innovative teaching methodologies
- Introducing competition in teaching and learning methods
- Developing ICT and mobility competencies
- Promoting perseverance and resilience as success tools
- Developing soft skills and use the motivational effects of robotics to excite students about science and technology

As a working model, this project will address Robotics as the topic of Learning.

The project will develop **4 training modules on Robotics** from basic to advanced level, available online in an **e-learning** format and free of charge.

The modules will be tested and there will be **3 mobility flows** to allow participation in 3 competitions.



What’s happened until now?

The project’s activities were launched at the partnership kick-off meeting, held in the facilities of Honoré de Balzac Model United Nations, in Paris, France, on the 28th and 29th of February 2020 where partners discussed project activities and the timeline.



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
